



ADULT DIPLOMA PROGRAM

Adult Diploma Program (ADP) is brought to you by the Ohio Department of Education in partnership with Knox Technical Center.

This program simultaneously offers career training, an industry credential, and a high school diploma to Ohio residents aged 22 and older, who have not obtained a high school diploma or GED. The program is FREE to eligible adults.

Adult Diploma Programs offered by Knox Technical Center:

State Tested Nurse Aid (STNA)

- Offered monthly
- Course is 3 weeks for a total of 76 hrs
- Career Pathway: Medical Assistant, Licensed Practical Nurse, Registered Nurse

Automotive Service Technician – Brakes

- Course is a total of 144 hrs, earns one certification
- Career Pathway: Continue or complete the Automotive Technician program with Knox Technical Center, Bachelor of Science Automotive Technology Supervision

Phlebotomy

- Course is a total of 174 hrs, including 40 clinical hrs
- Career Pathway: Medical Assistant, Licensed Practical Nurse, Registered Nurse

IT A+ Hardware/Software

- Course is a total of 300 hrs
- Career Pathway: Networking and Security Certificate, Information Technology Management

Certified Administrative Assistant

- Course is a total of 225 hrs
- Day or Evening classes available
- Career Pathway: Administrative Assistant, Executive Secretary, Office Assistant, Entry Level Accounting

Nail Technician

- Course is a total of 200 hrs
- Career Pathway: Manicurist, Nail Technician, Pedicurist
