Pre-Admission Testing Information

The pre-entrance tests for the LPN to RN Program are ATI-PN Comprehensive Predictor and ATI-PN Maternal Newborn Nursing, and the ACT WorkKeys Assessments on Applied Math, Graphic Literacy and Workplace Documents. Applicants that successfully complete the WorkKeys assessments earn a National Career Readiness Certificate.

WorkKeys (Testing completed at 308 Martinsburg Rd. location)

- ⇒ **The Applied Math Assessment** measures critical thinking, mathematical reasoning, and problem solving techniques for situations that actually occur in today's workplace. While individuals may use calculators and conversion tables to help with the problems on the assessment, math skills are still needed to think them through.
- ⇒ **The Graphic Literacy Assessment**, workplace graphics come in a variety of formats, but all communicate a level of information. From charts to graphs, diagrams to floor plans, identifying what information is being presented and understanding how to use it are critical to success. The Graphic Literacy assessment measures the skill needed to locate, synthesize, and use information from workplace graphics..
- ⇒ **The Workplace Documents Assessment**, testers need to be able to understand written text to do a job. The Workplace Documents assessment measures the skills people use when they read and use written text such as memos, letters, directions, signs, notices, bulletins, policies, and regulations on the job.

The website will describe the assessments in detail and provide example questions for practice. A score of 5 is required in all categories.

ATI Testing (Testing completed at 1481 Yauger Rd. location)

- ⇒ The PN Comprehensive Predictor is a 180 item assessment of comprehension and mastery of basic principles including fundamentals of nursing, pharmacology, adult medical-surgical nursing, maternal newborn care, mental health nursing, nursing care of children, nutrition and management. The test is based on current knowledge. Study resources can be materials used during LPN Program.
- ⇒ The PN Maternal Newborn Nursing (This test subject to change) is a 60 item test of basic comprehension and mastery of maternal newborn nursing principles including: Collecting data from low-risk antepartum clients, postpartum clients, and low-risk newborns. Identifying physiological and psychological changes of pregnancy. Using pharmacologic and nutritional interventions effectively. Preventing antepartum, postpartum, and neonatal complications. Having an awareness of and sensitivity to cultural considerations. Reinforcing teaching about newborn care and safety. Textbook available for study, PN Maternal Review Module, Edition 10.0. An online practice assessment is also available. Check ATI website for pricing.

Step 1: Pre-Entrance Test Dates- Testing will be scheduled upon payment of Registration fee.

Step 2: One week before ATI Testing

- ⇒ Applicants are required to create an ATI account prior to testing. Accounts can be created online at www.atitesting.com.

- ⇒ **Bring username and password on the day of testing**

Step 3: Day of ATI Testing

- ⇒ Please arrive by the designated time. Both ATI tests require approximately 4 hours to complete
- ⇒ Photo ID, ATI username, and password are required
